a. R 2021-7 Litter Ordinance

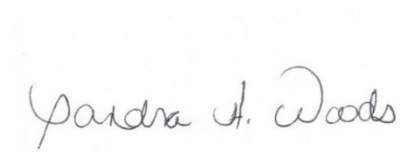
